

Getting Here

Located on Wolf Road, at the corner of Porter Creek Drive in the Cleveland Metroparks Huntington Reservation.

From the West, via Interstate 90 East:

- * Exit 156, Crocker-Bassett Roads.
- * Turn north (left) on Crocker Rd, which becomes Bassett Rd.
- * Turn east (right) on Wolf Road. Entrance will be .7 miles on the north (left) side of the road.

From the East, via Interstate 90 West:

- * Exit 159, Columbia Road north.
- * Turn right on Columbia Road.
- * Turn west (left) on Wolf Road. Entrance will be 1.9 miles on the north (right) side of the road.

From the South, Interstate 480:

- * Exit 3, Stearns Road.
- * Turn north (right) on Stearns. Stearns will become Crocker Rd. Shortly after passing over I-90, Crocker will become Bassett Road.
- * Turn east (right) on Wolf Road. Entrance will be .7 miles on the north (left) side of the road.
