GET READY FOR MARS AND METEORS AT LAKE ERIE NATURE & SCIENCE CENTER

Bay Village, Ohio --- The month of November will bring meteors and the planet Mars into view in the Northeast Ohio skies. Throughout the month, Lake Erie Nature & Science Center will feature programs in the Walter R. Schuele Planetarium that track Earth's fast closing pursuit of Mars. The programs will prepare sky watchers for the "Red Wonder's" closest approach in December. The world-class planetarium will also point the way for November's Leonids Meteor Shower. Expert planetarium staff will set up telescopes for free viewing following the 7 p.m. programs on the first and third Saturdays, November 3 and 17, weather permitting.
