## **'WONDER FULL' FALL SKY WILL HAVE YOU FALLING FOR THE STARS** *NOVEMBER MONTHLY SKYQUEST AT LAKE ERIE NATURE & SCIENCE CENTER*

*Bay Village, Ohio* --- The fall sky is full of wonder and Lake Erie Nature & Science Center is ready to point the way to autumn constellations, views of Uranus and Neptune, two meteor showers and a very bright object in the West! You can also find out about an asteroid named Sedna as the Walter R. Schuele Planetarium celebrates Sedna's closest approach to the sun during the month of November.

The action-packed "Falling for Fall" star shows will be featured throughout November at all Schuele Planetarium *Monthly Skyquest* programs. "Crisp autumn nights often supply some of the very best star gazing on our bi-monthly telescope nights," said Schuele Planetarium Director Jay Reynolds. "Of course, the stars are always out in our planetarium."

November *Monthly Skyquest* programs will be offered on all five November Saturdays, (November 1, 8, 15, 22, 29) at 2 p.m. with an admission fee of \$2 per person, and on Saturday, November 1 and 15 at 7 p.m. for \$3 per person. Free telescope viewing follows both 7 p.m. shows, weather permitting.

Also in the Schuele Planetarium in November:

- **Twinkle Tots** is a popular program for the toddler in your family. Watch lights dance across the sky, see some magic and learn what's new in space. This program, on Thursdays & Saturdays at 11 a.m., is just \$1 per person, including infants.
- **Stellar Stars** - Grab your passports and tour our solar system! This program is great for children 2 years and up and takes place Wednesdays at 11 a.m. & Saturdays at Noon. Tickets are \$2 per child.
- **Backyard Astronomy** delights family audiences of all ages on Saturdays at 1 p.m. Explore the night sky as it appears from your very own backyard! View autumn constellations and other celestial objects visible in the Northeast Ohio sky. Admission fee is \$2 per person.

Planetarium tickets are available at the front desk 30 minutes before the program begins on a first-come, first-served basis. With the exception of Twinkle Tots and Stellar Stars, programs may not be appropriate for very young children who are unable to sit through a 30-minute presentation.
