## CONNECT THE DOTS IN THE OCTOBER SKY AT LAKE ERIE NATURE & SCIENCE CENTER

**Bay Village, Ohio** --- Connect the dots in the autumn night skies and discover animals and geometric shapes overhead. Find out where to look and the myths behind the constellations by taking in a 2 p.m. or 7 p.m. Saturday show in Lake Erie Nature & Science Center's Schuele Planetarium throughout the month of October. You can even put your new knowledge into practice on the first and third Saturdays, when telescope viewing follows the 7 p.m. show.

#### The Autumn Sky

**October 6\*, 13, 20\*, 27**

A Dolphin, a horse, a square, even a triangle are in tonight's sky. Why don't they stand out? We will bring out our special constellation projector and explain other mythologies. Where is the Big Dipper? Can I see Uranus & Neptune like last autumn? By the end of our program, you will discover the answers!

#### Backyard Astronomy

**Saturdays at 1 p.m.**

Explore the night sky from your very own backyard! Join us as we view autumn constellations and other celestial objects in the sky.

**Fee: \$2/person**

With the exception of Twinkle Tots and Stellar Stars, programs may not be appropriate for very young children who are not able to sit through a 30-minute show. All shows include an overview of the night sky and news from various space agencies.
