PROTECT YOUR IDENTITY AND THE ENVIRONMENT AT SHREDDING DAY *LAKE ERIE NATURE & SCIENCE CENTER TEAMS UP WITH SHREDDING NETWORK*

Bay Village, Ohio --- You can dispose of old financial statements, tax forms, bills, medical records and other clean paper without worrying about identity theft or the effect of dumping paper into the environment. Lake Erie Nature & Science Center is teaming up with the Shredding Network to bring a powerful mobile shredding truck to Bay Village on Saturday, October 25. The high-tech equipment will provide quick, confidential destruction and recycling of up to five boxes or bags of old paper per household.

“In one month’s time, you will literally be buying back your old paper in the form of paper towels or other tissue products,” said Shredding Network’s Dana Mueller. “Unlike some mobile shredding outfits, we maintain chain of custody of the shredded materials and shred them a second time back at our physical plant. The material is then baled and shipped to the paper mill, where it’s turned into new paper products.”

The mobile shredder will be set up across from Lake Erie Nature & Science Center in the Wolf Picnic Pavilion area of Huntington Reservation from 9 a.m. to Noon. The portable equipment cross-shreds in one pass and is powerful enough to handle checks and legal pads, with the capability to process up to 8,000 pounds of paper per hour. If you’re in a hurry on shredding day, you can simply hand the technician up to five bags or boxes of confidential papers and keep going. You’re also welcome to park and watch the process. While you’re waiting to shred, Lake Erie Nature & Science Center will have some resident wildlife on hand to inspire you to continue to take the time to recycle and care for the habitat we share with our animal neighbors. The shredding service will be provided for a suggested donation of \$5 per household and 100% of the proceeds will go directly to the non-profit Lake Erie Nature & Science Center.

Lake Erie Nature & Science Center provides wildlife exhibits and rehabilitation, as well as planetarium and nature education programming to more than 100,000 visitors every year. Although the Center is located in Huntington Reservation, it is a separate organization funded by donations from individuals, businesses and foundations. Shredding Network is a locally owned company based in Wickliffe, Ohio. The company shreds and recycles 2,000 tons of paper per month!
