Position Summary

Lake Erie Nature & Science Center is seeking interns to take part in a unique educational opportunity by assisting with wildlife rehabilitation, animal care and public education.

Responsibilities include:

- Assist with caring for wildlife admitted to the wildlife rehabilitation program
- Assist in the cleaning, feeding and additional daily care of the resident animals
- Assist with public education and programming
- Department administrative and organization duties

Schedule & Compensation

All positions are non-paid however may qualify for course credit. Generally, the work day begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 4:30 p.m.

Qualifications

The preferred applicant should have coursework focused on pre-vet, environmental sciences, biology, zoology or related field. Previous animal care experience is preferred.

Showing initiative within the framework of the organization's priorities, being able to work as part of a team, having the ability to prioritize simultaneous tasks and having experience with computers and Microsoft Office software are all necessary attributes.

Having and maintaining a legal Ohio Drivers permit, and being in good enough physical condition to load and push full wheelbarrows and carry a 50 pound bag of animal food are required.
