The wonder of the outdoors is calling you! Learn about the birds in your neighborhood and how they get from place to place. Watch for wild creatures while on a short hike. REGISTRATION & REFUND POLICY

- Register online at www.lensc.org, call **440-871-2900 x211**, or email scouts@lensc.org. Full payment is due at time of registration.
- Fees: \$10 per scout; \$5 per additional child or adult
- Pre-registration required for all programs and is accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- **Program registration closes 48 hours before the scheduled program.**
- Sign up as a whole den/pack or as an individual scout! Individual scouts must have an adult participant in attendance.
- Notification is required at least one week prior to the scheduled program to be eligible for a refund. A service fee of 5% will be assessed.

PLEASE NOTE

- Our programs meet the requirements of the Cub Scout Adventure curriculum.
- Age-appropriate activities are designed for program participants. You are welcome to enjoy the Center exhibits but for the safety, concentration and enjoyment of the Scouts, we ask parents not to bring children ages 3 and under to the program.
- The time listed on your confirmation is the starting time for the program. Please arrive 15 minutes early to allow for check-in.
