<p>Summary of Activities Assist with the daily cleaning, feeding and care to more than 160+ species of animals. During peak migratory periods there will be a great need to assist with native songbirds injured during migration. Other animals may include birds of prey, mammals, reptiles and amphibians and aquatic animals under the direction of the wildlife staff.</p> <p>Daily duties include</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cage set-up, cleaning and disinfecting as directed. • Preparation of daily diets, fresh water and medications. • Monitor animal health and well-being.
