Job Posting: Preschool Specialist, part-time

Position Summary: The Preschool Specialist is responsible for teaching science and nature-based programs for children ages 0 to 6 including session classes, adult and child programs, summer camps, preschool field trips, preschool planetarium shows and some seasonal family programs. The Preschool Specialist is responsible for planning, preparing, and teaching preschool programs for children, and occasional family events. This position will include training and animal handling. The Preschool Specialist must follow the Center's handbook and adhere to its COVID-19 protocols. Regular safety training is required. This part-time position is eligible for the Center's 401k plan and membership benefits of the Northeastern Ohio Inter-Museum Council.

Schedule: This part-time year-round position requires 6 to 24 hours per week including some Saturdays and occasional evenings.

Qualifications: Candidates must have a minimum of two years' experience teaching early childhood programs. Early childhood certification or training is preferred. Training and background in preschool counseling, learning interventions, biology, natural sciences, environmental education or related fields a plus.

Organization: Lake Erie Nature & Science Center connects people to the natural world with engaging programs for children and families, space science programs, wildlife rehabilitation and education, and live animal exhibits. It is the only facility providing wildlife rehabilitation in Cuyahoga County; it is one of two public access planetariums in Cleveland; it features one of the region's first and largest nature-based preschool programs; and it is located in a park setting near Lake Erie. The Center is funded by private donations, program fees, grants, and Cuyahoga Arts & Culture through the residents of Cuyahoga County.

Started in 1998, the Center's nature-based preschool program is one of the first and largest in the region. Classes engage children's inherent curiosity about the world by using play based, hands on, and nature-based activities to foster social, physical, and academic development. Its preschool teachers encourage children to develop an attitude of inquiry and respect for the natural world through a variety of programs that involve animals, exhibits, planetarium, and park setting. Dynamic age-appropriate activities integrate science, math, literacy, and the arts while encouraging cooperative learning and social competence.
