KINDERGARTEN

GIZMOS AND GADGETS ELECTIVE ADVENTURE

Learn about forces and motion in this hands-on program! Explore forces with hands-on activities and discover how using things like force and motion help to get things done. Finally, make your own useful object with supplies provided by the Center.

MOUNTAIN LION CORE ADVENTURE

Identify the cub scout 6 essentials and then head outside on a hike. Discover natural and man-made objects while out on the trail. Learn how to stay safe while hiking and see what wild animals live in your area. **This program goes outdoors; please dress for the weather.**

CHAMPIONS FOR NATURE ELECTIVE ADVENTURE

Learn about natural resources and man-made items. Discover the difference between organic, paper, and glass waste and then play a recycling game. Learn about native pollinators including bees and take some seeds home to start your own pollinator garden.

CHAMPIONS FOR NATURE ELECTIVE ADVENTURE

Learn about renewable and nonrenewable resources, and play a fun recycling game to learn the basics of reduce, reuse and recycle. Discover what happens to the garbage in your community. Then, make a planter from recycled materials as part of a conservation project.

TIGERS IN THE WILD CORE ADVENTURE

Gather your cub scout 6 essentials, head out on a hike, and carry your own gear. Learn the Outdoor Code before you go. While outside, identify natural and man-made materials and see what animals and trees you can find. Come back inside and record your experience in a picture. **This program goes outdoors; please dress for the weather.**

SECOND GRADE

PAWS ON THE PATH CORE ADVENTURE

Great ready to go on a hike! Identify what to bring and what to leave home, gather your cub scout 6 essentials and your hiking buddy. Learn the Outdoor Code and Leave No Trace Principles and then head out on a 30-minute hike. While outside look for plants and animals and see what you can find! **This program goes outdoors; please dress for the weather.**

FINDING YOUR WAY ELECTIVE ADVENTURE

Work on your map and compass skills as you prepare to find objects in the woods. Find where you live on a map, learn the parts of a map and draw your own map. **This program goes outdoors; please dress for the weather.**

AIR OF THE WOLF ELECTIVE ADVENTURE

Calling all paper airplane enthusiasts! We will put our skills to the test and build several different types of airplanes and measure their distance and time. We will compare the designs and see which one is best. Then build an airplane out of something other than paper!

BEAR HABITAT CORE ADVENTURE

Carrying your Cub Scout 6 essentials, head outdoors on a hike and practice all seven principles of *leave no trace* on a 1-mile hike. **Please dress for the weather and wear appropriate clothing and shoes.**

SUPER SCIENCE ELECTIVE ADVENTURE

Let's have some fun while conducting science experiments! We will learn about static electricity, color, and density throughout this fun-filled program. Discover that you too can be a home scientist!

FOURTH–FIFTH GRADE

EARTH ROCKS! ADVENTURE

Explore the fascinating world of geology as you hike trails, look for rocks and identify building materials made of rocks and minerals. Use a mineral test kit to measure hardness. Learn about the rock cycle and take home instructions to grow your own crystal. **This program goes outdoors; please dress for the weather.**

This program completes requirements 1–3. We will give you instructions for requirement 4, but that must be done at home with an adult's help as the crystals take time to grow!
